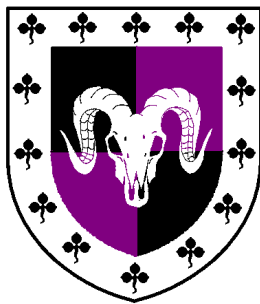
## Salutations of the Knight Marshall

From the District Office continue South on Highway 337 4 1/2 to Juan Tomas Road. Turn East on Juan Tomas for 1 mile until the junction of Forest Road 252. Proceed North on Forest Road 252 approximately 1 mile and follow signs to Cedro Peak Campground.

Fire Restrictions will be posted one week prior to event and are subject to change. Final say on fire rules will be set by the Tijeras Fire Marshall and will be available at the site.
