Greetings unto the fine Barony of Fontaine and any who come by these words,

As you already know, we had two large events this month in the Outlands, Spring Coronation and Grand Outlandish.

At Coronation one of Fontaine's very own Charlie Moquin aka William fought in the Protector of the Queen's Heart Tournament. He didn't win, but he was said to have fought very honorably and with tons of chivalry. Don Angus assisted with marshalling of the tourney, a job that is always appreciated.

At Grand Outlandish Don Angus was once again amazing with his drive. He stepped up to Schola's challenge and in their words "Don Angus was quite the zealot and challenged us incessantly starting early Friday morning and continuing through to Sunday evening as court was about to start" Don Angus racked up 69 kills and 104 deaths for a total of 173 fights, over 100 fights more than the second place contender who came in with 25 kills and 36 deaths for 71 fights. WOW!!! Big numbers for the Baby Don. Also of note, Sorren mounted up 11 kills and 32 deaths to come in fifth place and edged out Master Duncan who had 9 kills and 19 deaths in sixth. Huzzah to Fontaine!!!! And Huzzah to the OUTLANDS!!!

As fighters here we find ourselves, deep within the heart of our tourney season. Several challenges have passed, and yet so many are ahead. As we look back on past battles and remember how each was lost or won we should use each as a tool to future battles.
