She showed us several techniques to do the transfers with as well as how to enlarge them for big items. Everyone had a chance to transfer a pattern onto fabric and get their hands in it.

Next month we will be meeting on September 22nd because the second Tuesday is the day after Warders. Not fun. Lady Isabella will take the class on a tour of JoAnn's fabrics to get a feel for the different kinds of fabrics available and which ones to avoid. We will return to their Excellencies house for a tour of a pattern. (Basics on how to read a pattern.) Many people have asked for information on both fabrics and patterns.

The Black and Blue Challenge will be held at Warders. Some details still need to be finalized. The Vert Warder Competition is in much better shape than a week ago. We have the 2 outside challenges for the Warder, but several people have spoken to me about planning to enter.
