Constitution for the
Order of the Golden Paw

- I. There shall exist in the Barony of Fontaine dans Sable an award, known as the Golden Paw, which may be given by the Coronet to those persons who have demonstrated extraordinary skill and assiduous dedication in the art of Rapier.
- II. The holders of this award shall be styled as Companions of the Order of the Golden Paw and shall be entitled to place the initials G.P. after their names.
- III. Subject to the College of Arms, the insignia of the Order shall consist of a medallion bearing the badge of the Order, to wit: Azure, a lion's gambe Or bendwise armed and distilling gouttes gules, an orle of fleurs-de-lis points to center argent.
- IV. IV. The award shall convey neither arms nor precedence.
- V. Amendments to this constitution shall be made by the Coronet.

A few notes on Life in the Current Middle Ages:

When one is in garb, remember that we are recreating the Middle Ages. During that time of history, respect and honor were commonplace. In our modern world we tend to speak in slang and rarely, if ever, use a title with someone's name. However, during the Middle Ages, unless in very intimate situations, titles were always used in conjunction with a name, i.e. Lord Big Sword, Lady Beautiful, Duke Wondrous, etc. Speech was proper and the real words, not slang was used.

If you are at an event and do not know an individual's title, using M'Lady or M'Lord is always appropriate. The term of My Lady and My Lord is used for someone who has been given an Award of Arms (AOA), but if you are unsure, then use M'Lady or M'Lord. And, if someone is wearing a "crown" (commonly referred to as a hat) you may feel free to address them as "Your Excellency" if you do recognize the style of hat for the appropriate title. Learning to identify various hat styles takes a bit of learning, but addressing the individual as "Your Excellency" always works. If someone is wearing a metal circlet on their head, then you can be assured that you may address them as Ladyship or Lordship. It is very uncommon to see a person of high rank without a retinue accompanying them. The more retinue present, the higher the rank. And, often the Royals walk about with Guards. A good suggestion is to go online to the Outlands website (Outlands.org) and look at pictures of both the Majesties and various Barons and Baronesses to become familiar with faces and types of hats.

When a person of rank enters your presence, if you are sitting you should stand until told you may "be comfortable." If you are walking and a person of rank approaches you, you should bow or curtsy as a show of respect. Even if you are not acknowledged by your actions, the respect is still due the nobility.

When in garb, you should never address an individual by their mundane name – you should always use their persona name. If you are unsure of the name, ask the individual if the situation is appropriate. Some names are hard to pronounce and if you cannot remember the name, use the title.

Wherever there are thrones set up, even when empty, there is a circle of respect surrounding the thrones. This area is a circle 10 to 15 feet out from the thrones. If you are walking past an empty throne, you should do a slight curtsey or bow to the throne. This is a show of loyalty and respect for the reign. At no time should anyone sit in an empty throne chair (unless of course, it is yours to sit in). Smalls (children) should not be allowed to play in and around the thrones.

If a person of title is engaged in conversation and you wish to speak with them, move into their line of vision, but not within hearing distance of what is being said. The Noble will see you in their line of vision and when appropriate, motion you to come forward into their presence. It is never appropriate to rush up to a Noble or Royal and approach without being recognized or interrupt their conversation. The only exception to this would be a situation of danger to the individual.

I challenge anyone who reads this to practice the respect, courtesy and chivalry of what we recreate in our own Middle Ages.

**Constitution for the
Order of the Silver Tyne**

- I. There shall exist in the Kingdom of the Outlands an award, known as the Order of the Silver Tyne, which may be given by the Crown to those persons who have demonstrated excellence in the art of fencing, giving freely of their expertise in the use and artistry of the rapier.
- II. The holders of this award shall be styled as Defenders of the Silver Tyne and shall be entitled to place the initials D.S.T. after their names.
- III. The insignia of the Order shall consist of some rendition of a silver stag's antler, or a medallion bearing the registered badge of the Order: Vert, a stag's attire palewise argent, a bordure embattled Or.
- IV. Arms and precedence:
- A. The award shall carry with it an Award of Arms. Companions of the order shall take precedence after simple Grants of Arms.
- B. If the award is given to a person who bears an award carrying higher precedence than given above, his/her precedence shall remain unchanged.
- C. If the award is given to a person who has previously received an Award of Arms, his/her precedence shall date from his/her election to the Order.
- V. Amendments to this constitution shall be made by the Crown of the Outlands.
- VI. Companionship of all previous recipients of the Order is hereby confirmed.
- By our hands this 27th day of March , A.S. XXXIII, being 1999 in the Common Era.

Constitution for the Order of the White Scarf

I. There shall exist in the Kingdom of the Outlands an award, known as the Order of the White Scarf, which may be given by the Crown to those persons who have demonstrated extraordinary skill in the art of fence, meeting certain minimum requirements including proficiency in a variety of styles. Other qualifications include leadership, activity level, and teaching. Said individuals must also display unquestionable honor both on and off the field.

II. The holders of this award shall be styled as Defenders of the White Scarf and may be addressed as Don or Dōna, and shall be entitled to place the initials D.W.S. after their names.

III. The insignia of the Order shall consist of some rendition of a white scarf worn under the arm and tied at the shoulder, and/or a medallion bearing the registered badge of the Order: "Sable, on a pale argent between two rapiers proper, a stag's antler vert".

IV. Arms and precedence:

A. The award shall carry with it a Grant of Arms. Companions of the order shall take precedence before simple Grants of Arms.

B. If the award is given to a person who bears an award carrying higher precedence than given above, his/her precedence shall remain unchanged.

C. If the award is given to a person who has previously received a Grant of Arms, his/her precedence shall be elevated with his/her election to the Order.

V. The Crown of the Outlands shall consult with such members of the Order as they shall desire concerning the recognition of new members of the Order.

VI. Amendments to this constitution shall be made by the Crown of the Outlands.

VII. Companionship of all previous recipients of the Order is hereby confirmed. For recipients of this Order living outside the boundaries of our Kingdom, permission has been given by the Crowns of those Kingdoms for this elevation and a Grant of Arms if the award did not originally bear this rank when the recipient was first awarded this Order.

By our hands this 9th day of November, A.S. XXXVII, being 2002 in the Common Era.
