We were most pleased to admit Lady veroniqua and Lady alamanda into the keeper of the waters for their excellent service as officers and coordinators.

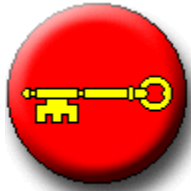
LORD ROWLAND, it was the baron's great honor to give you the baron's thistle.

Theme: Romeo and Juliet aka Angus and Elizabeth

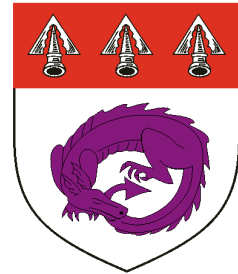
But this time, the story turns out much better!!! Less drama and more love!
