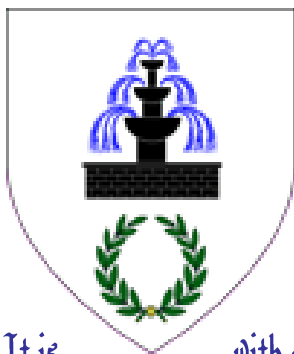

Hear the Words of the Baron & Baroness of Fontaine

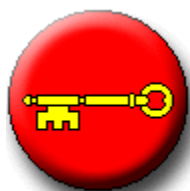
Greetings Unto the Wonderful Populace of Fontaine dans Sable-

GREETING ALL,



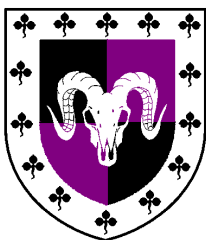

News from the Exchequer

Greetings unto the Populace!

In an effort to be more open with our finances, I will be submitting a financial report to the newsletter each quarter. This month I have included the numbers for the First Quarter of 2011. The reports are divided into Income and Expenses, with the Net Income being the difference (Income - Expenses). Since this is the first report, please allow me to explain some of the items:

Activity Related Income- site fees from events, and any fees that we receive for "doing what we do" (such as demos or Renn Faires)

Fundraising- non-medieval activities done to raise money (silent auction, raffles, car wash) either at an event or separately

Interest- the interest earned from our checking account

Equipment Rental/Maintenance- money used to maintain our equipment or rent equipment (such as maintaining the hold, renting porta-potties for an event)

Food- Food!! Things like a feast or lunch at an event or meeting.

General Supplies- "dry goods" used for an event (materials for site tokens or decorations) or for the running of the Barony

Other Expenses- a catch-all category for anything that doesn't fit elsewhere

Travel- This is to reimburse Their Excellencies for travel to events such as Crown Tournament or Coronation as part of their duties to the Kingdom.

Funds Transferred to Kingdom- any funds that we send to Kingdom of the Outlands (fundraising proceeds, heraldic submissions)

If you have any questions about the financial report or the office of the Chancellor of the Exchequer, I'll be happy to answer them!

Missives from the Minister of Children



Good Day!

As the weather (maybe) warms, and we all look toward enjoying outdoor practices and events, I would like to take the opportunity to bring a few ideas to parents, as they prepare for their children. I will first concentrate on practices, and then move to camping.

One of the first things most parents do in the spring is to acquire new boots for their children. This is prompted not only by the never-ending outgrowing of shoes, but also in the clearance of winter boots. Practices are a great time to break in those new boots, the short time span and activity level makes the process much easier. Plan to bring some moleskin to practices, to help out with any blisters that might begin, as it is a much better product than adhesive bandages, before the blister is formed. Ask your kids to tell you as soon as they feel a rubbing, and definitely if it begins to hurt. It is far easier, and less painful to prevent a blister than to treat it.

Another important type of items for parents to bring to practices this time of year is sting products. As the flowers bloom, the spiders, bees, and other stinging insects begin to come out of hibernation, and start getting at their task. Unfortunately for kids, they tend to be closest to the stinging insects hangout spots, long grass, flowering plants, and bug hide-y-holes like pipes, trees, within rocks, playground equipment and enclosures. Those kids with allergies will usually be well taken care of, with emergency medications. This is something that is occasionally overlooked for the rest of kids. Stinging bug kits are available at most retail pharmacy or department stores, but minimally keep some tweezers, Benadryl cream, and topical pain relief to help them out.

Most importantly, make certain your children are taught to look around for insects, and if stung, to be observant of what stung them. A wasp sting probably will need no medical attention; however a spider bite should be looked at by a doctor. A bit of focus could save you the stress and cost of unnecessary medical treatment...or the nightmare possible by leaving a poisonous bite untreated.
