Cotehardie Classes

Greetings,

I know this isn't exactly a gab and gab but there is a great set of sewing classes coming up in October.....

Lady Alamanda is proud to announce a series of classes in how to make a gothic fitted dress, otherwise known as a self-supportive cotehardie. At the end of the series you will have a muslin pattern as well as a finished cote ready to wear!

The cote will be custom made to fit YOUR body so it is one of the more flattering style of dresses (expect lots of compliments). In addition, the cote can be as supportive of the bust as you want, from not needing to wear a bra at all (even I think they are comfortable and that's saying something!) to fairly loose. Because we will be fitting the cote on you as we go you get to decide!

The series will take place over 3 sessions on October 16, 23, and 30:

Session 1 (October 16th, 3 PM-7PM, HE Elizabeth's house) In this session we will be working in pairs to create a muslin pattern fitted to your body. The pattern will be loose so you will be able to use it for both supportive under gowns and looser over gowns. MATERIALS NEEDED: 3-4 yards of muslin (depending how long you want the pattern), Sharpie or other permanent marker, strongly colored thread, needle, scissors.

In-between sessions: If you would like to continue with the course, you will cut out the 4 panels of your dress based on your muslin pattern. MATERIALS NEEDED: 5-7 yards of linen or other non-stretch material depending on how tall you are, your size, and how many gores you want (I generally go for more fabric rather than less), pattern, scissors.

Session 2 (October 23rd, 3PM-7 PM, Lady Alamanda's house) In this session we will sew the garment and begin with basic fitting. This will require intermediate level sewing skills! If you can follow a mundane pattern you will probably be

OK. I will also discuss options for finishing the garment (closure and sleeve options as well as different seam finishes). MATERIALS NEEDED: Pre-cut quarter panels and gores, sewing machine, thread, scissors, and pins.

Session 3 (October 30th, 3PM-7PM, Lady Alamanda's house) In this session we will do the final fitting and construct and set S-curve sleeves into the cote. We will also do as much of the finishing as you would like (or you can do it at home!). MATERIALS NEEDED: Cote, about 1 yd of material for the sleeves, sewing machine, thread, scissors, pins.
