stoplight turn right onto College Blvd. San Juan
College will be on the left at the first stoplight.*

From the North- From Durango take US 550 South. In Aztec, continue straight onto NM 516 west (do NOT turn onto Main Street). Drive approximately 9 miles, and turn right onto Pinon Hills Blvd. Drive 1.5 miles and turn left onto College Blvd. San Juan College will be on the right at the first stoplight.
